What is the Yellow Ribbon Program?

The Yellow Ribbon GI Education Enhancement Program (Yellow Ribbon Program) is a provision of the Post 9/11 Veterans Educational Assistance Act of 2008. The Program enables institutions of higher learning to enter into an agreement with the Veterans Administration (VA) to fund tuition expenses that exceed the highest public in-state undergraduate tuition rate (in Colorado, the maximum allowable tuition is \$497 per credit hour).

The Yellow Ribbon Program enables private schools like Regis University College for Professional Studies (CPS) to provide undergraduate and graduate education to soldiers who served after 9/11 by making tuition costs competitive with other schools.

How much does a veteran save at Regis University CPS as a result of the Yellow Ribbon Program?

► The Post 9/11 GI Bill provides the veteran eligible for 100% benefit with \$497 per credit hour. Undergraduate classroom Regis University CPS tuition is \$360 per credit hour, and online tuition is \$460, so the GI Bill will cover the entire classroom and online tuition at Regis University CPS.

Graduate students save even more because graduate tuition in the Schools of Management and Computer Information Sciences exceeds the Colorado in-state maximum of \$497. For example, online graduate tuition (MBA) in the School of Management is \$825 per credit hour. Through Yellow Ribbon, Regis pays 20% of the difference between \$825 and \$497, or \$65.60 per credit hour. The VA matches that same amount of \$65.60, or up to \$518 in the School of Management and \$410 in the School of Computer & Information Sciences annually.



WHO CAN TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE YELLOW RIBBON PROGRAM?

The provisions of the Yellow Ribbon Program apply only to eligible Veterans who are Regis University CPS students, enrolled in a degree or academic certificate program. The number of eligible veterans who can participate in the Yellow Ribbon Program at Regis University College for Professional Studies is unlimited.

Step 1:

Post 9/11 Veterans who are interested in the Post 9/11 GI Bill and the Yellow Ribbon Program at Regis University CPS must be verified by the VA as to their eligibility and associated benefits.

Step 2:

Once the VA determines an individual's eligibility for the Post 9/11 GI Bill, then they may be eligible to receive benefits under the Yellow Ribbon Program.
