

MASTER OF ARTS IN MARRIAGE & FAMILY THERAPY

DEGREE AND POST-GRADUATE CERTIFICATE OPTIONS

This degree prepares students to provide professional guidance and counseling based on in-depth research and the theory that mental health and family problems are best treated in a family context. The program provides students with hands-on training through six credit-hours of Practicum in a state-of-the-art counseling laboratory and essential clinical experience through two semesters of supervised internships at local mental health counseling agencies.
