

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN ORGANIZATION LEADERSHIP DEGREE PROGRAM

This degree explores leadership from a strategic, tactical perspective while offering an opportunity to cultivate the leadership skills to think critically, create vision based on ethical values, discern the future, take risks, and institute change within an organization. The curriculum is a blend of contemporary management practices that focus on leading people, developing teams, and facilitating change in a global environment. Through Regis' partnership with the Aubrey Daniels International (ADI), the science of performance management and executive leadership practices are incorporated into the curriculum as well, ensuring our students learn management practices that bring out the best in organizational structure, mitigate project risk, and maximize employee performance management.
