

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN ACCOUNTING DEGREE PROGRAM

This degree is designed for those interested in broadening and deepening their skills in accounting. The program has a strong foundation in ethics which is in high demand by corporations and accounting licensing bodies. In addition, the classes may help students meet the "150 Hour Requirement" for the CPA exam requirements for the Certified Management Accountant designation. It is a 30-credit-hour program with an additional eight foundation courses (these courses may be waived).
