

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN INFORMATION ASSURANCE DEGREE PROGRAM

This degree prepares students to manage the risks to information assets such as protecting confidentiality, integrity, and availability of data and their delivery systems whether the data are in storage, processing, or transit and whether threatened by malice or accident. Courses are appropriate for government employees, CSOs, working security professionals, and entry level security personnel. The courses emphasize the ten domains of knowledge that are emphasized by the CISSP certification standard.
