

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN INFORMATION ASSURANCE DEGREE PROGRAM

This degree program offers a complete approach to information protection and computer security by protecting the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of data and their delivery systems. Regis University is designated as a Center of Academic Excellence in Information Assurance Education by the National Security Agency. The curriculum for this degree is modeled on the curricula guidelines and recommendations provided by the Committee on National Security Systems (CNSS) 4000 training standards, the (ICS)2 International Information Systems Security Certification Consortium Ten Domains of Knowledge, and the International Security Audit and Controls Association (ISACA).
