

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN SOFTWARE ENGINEERING DEGREE PROGRAM

This degree prepares students for software analysis and design, construction, testing, and maintenance tasks. The program instructs students on the process of assessing requirements in analysis, design, construction, operation, configuration, and maintenance of software. The student will be equipped with the knowledge of modern software development technologies and techniques like object-oriented design, the use of middleware, enterprise design patterns, Java, C++, and C# programming languages.
