

## BACHELOR OF FINE ARTS IN FILM AND VIDEO DEGREE PROGRAM

The Bachelor of Fine Arts in Film and Video is designed as a rigorous, interdisciplinary-based program in the study and practice of film/video, with specializations in Production or Screenwriting. Building upon a strong foundation of film/video writing, directing, producing, cinematography, editing and acting for the screen, Production Specialization students will collaborate on an Advanced Production thesis film. Advanced Screenwriting Specialization students will take a feature idea from logline, treatment, and outline, all the way through to the completion of a final thesis draft.

## BACHELOR OF FINE ARTS IN FILM AND VIDEO DEGREE PROGRAM

### MISSION

The mission of the Regis University film and video department is to create an atmosphere where students take leadership roles, think logically and critically, and become socially and ethically responsible. Through theory and practice, we encourage students to discover their individual voice and foster original and creative work in the generous spirit of collaboration with each other.

### FILM PRODUCTION (BFA)

Building upon a strong foundation of film/video production; writing, directing, producing, cinematography, editing, and acting for the screen students will collaborate on an Advanced Production thesis film in their area of study. The program is designed to foster a creative, supportive, and collaborative environment. Through each stage of production a filmmaker Artist in Residence will work directly with students on their thesis project. A professional production faculty member will mentor and oversee the entire production from development to post production.

### SCREENWRITING (BFA)

The screenplay is the foundation on which the entire filmmaking process rests. Over four eight-week classes, Advanced Screenwriting Students will take an idea from logline, treatment, and outline, all the way through to the completion of a first draft. Students will also analyze the strengths and weaknesses of the screenplay, devising a project-specific rewrite strategy before leaving the program. The entire course will be facilitated by a professional screenwriter with continuing real-world experience, who will both guide workshops and introduce students to feature writing tools and concepts.

### ARTIST IN RESIDENCE PROGRAM

This unique program allows Advanced Production and Screenwriting students the opportunity to work one-on-one with leading industry filmmakers on their final thesis film or feature screenplay. Film study students also have an opportunity to discuss related topics with the Artist in Residence at film screenings and lectures. Past Artists have included *Avatar* Oscar award winning Cinematographer Mauro Fiore, "Director of the Decade," Ramin Bahrani, and Variety's Top Ten Screenwriters to Watch and *Brooklyn's Finest* writer Michael C Martin.
