

BACHELOR OF ARTS IN RELIGIOUS STUDIES DEGREE PROGRAM

This degree is based on Jesuit education principles and encourages adult students to develop a sense of responsibility for themselves and the community and to use their talents for leadership and service to others. Two areas of emphasis are presented: the first will provide the scholarly background needed by the potential student of Theology who intends to continue their studies in graduate school; the second is a focus in Spirituality which will provide knowledge of spiritual and religious tradition.
